Beechpoint's summer camp is a ministry of Child Evangelism Fellowship of Chicago. Our purpose is to share the saving grace of Jesus Christ with boys and girls and to aid in drawing them to the foot of the cross.

We also focus on nurturing the growth of young believers through the ministry of a caring, loving, committed staff, a fun-filled program, a spiritual emphasis, which underlies every activity, and a year-round discipleship program.

Camp Beechpoint is for children ages 8-14. Resident camps start on the third week of June and end the first week of August. There are seven consecutive sessions, each beginning Sunday afternoon and ending Friday after supper.

Beechpoint is located 150 miles northeast of Chicago in Allegan, Michigan. Activities include archery, riflery, crafts, swimming, canoeing, paddleboating, tubing, horses, go-carts, hiking, field games, BMX bikes, cook-outs, tree house, missionary times, firesides, Bible exploration, and lots of fun!

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS...

- ⇒ High School Student (age 15 and older or Sophomore and up).
- ⇒ Commitment to Jesus Christ as Savior.
- ⇒ Willingness to mature and grow as a Christian.
- ⇒ Capability to take and follow instructions; responding well to leadership.
- ⇒ Must enjoy and work well with CHILDREN!
- ⇒ Receive training prior to volunteering.
- ⇒ Good self-concept reflected in appearance, behavior, and relationships with others.
- ⇒ Raise minimum \$100.00 fee (additional funds offset camper scholarships).

CONDUCT...

- ⇒ All volunteers are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with the the goals and ministry of Beechpoint Camp.
- ⇒ All volunteers are expected to be subject to regulations regarding lights out, visitors, automobiles, cell phones, tidiness, neatness of dress, and personal conduct.

HOW YOU WILL SERVE !!!

- ⇒ Assist program staff with group activities and special events: cook-outs, bonfires, praise time, chapel, zip line, go carts, target sports, farm, etc.
- ⇒ Assist with skits/drama/music.
