This program is designed to help young people (age 14-18) learn to lead and to give them an entry-point into a lifetime of leading and giving through service. It is a pre-requisite for those who hope to be junior staff members at Beechpoint.

The participant will be provided with the book *Totally True*, and will be expected to read and study it during training. The training will include sessions on spiritual leadership, recreational leadership and safety, needs and differences in children, team building (challenge course), and responsibilities of leadership.

**Each participant will have a service role on the support staff**, but will also have opportunities during each day to assist in leading and mentoring campers.

- † How to lead a small group discussion.
- † How to work for the glory of God.
- † How to encourage and build up others.
